

# ABSTRACT SUBMISSIONS



You are invited to submit an abstract for e-poster and oral presentations at ICS State of the Art Meeting 2018, on 10-12th Dec. If you have worked on a project or have an interesting clinical case, submit an abstract for a chance to showcase your work to an international audience of over 1000 peers.

## Options

We have 5 categories for showcasing your work

1. E-poster Presentation (present your poster in main exhibition area)
2. Clinical Practice and Research Free Presentation (platform on main stage)
3. Pecha Kucha (open to all nurses, AHPs and doctors in training - pop up stage)
4. The Cauldron (compete for the trainee prize, platform on main stage)
5. The Intensive Care Foundation Gold Medal Award (platform on main stage)

For the e-poster and platform presentation, please go to our on-line submission's page <https://soa.ics.ac.uk/submit-an-abstract-for-state-of-the-art-2018/>. You have the option to submit your work for consideration for e-poster or platform presentation or both. The top 5 abstracts will be offered the opportunity to present on the stage on one of the concurrent sessions. E-posters will be presented throughout the conference.

## Abstract preparation guidance

For website **electronic submissions** (e-poster and Clinical Practice and Research Free Presentation), the font and character limit is clearly defined. Please see instructions using the abstract submission link here <https://soa.ics.ac.uk/submit-an-abstract-for-state-of-the-art-2018/>

For **email submissions** (Pecha Kucha, Cauldron and Gold Medal) please submit a word document using the following format:

1. Abstract title
2. All authors' initials, last names and place where work was carried out
3. The text of the abstract - this should not contain headings, but should follow a general progression through background, methods, results and conclusion
4. a maximum of 5 References; listed and cited as specified by the Journal of the Intensive Care Society
5. A maximum of two tables or figures are permitted - these should be incorporated into the document
6. Acknowledgement of sources of funding if applicable
7. The following statement (if applicable and true): "This study received ethics committee approval or equivalent"

## Key information

Use 12 point font, times new roman, single line spacing

**Word limit** (not including references)

500 words for Pecha Kucha and Cauldron

1000 words for Gold Medal
